Two current members of GCIA are needed to sponsor the prospective member. The GCIA Membership Committee will screen the application, which then requires approval of the GCIA Board of Directors. Membership is renewable annually. Termination is at the discretion of two-thirds votes of the Board of Directors.

**General Information**

GCIA was incorporated as a non-profit corporation in 1997 for the purpose of promoting, developing and maintaining the captive insurance industry in Guam. To meet these objectives, GCIA provides the means to communicate with others involved in the captive industry; those who might consider forming a captive company in the future; and with other entities, such as legislative bodies, whose actions affect the captive insurance industry.
