In seven comprehensive chapters, it covers everything company directors, business owners, and those in the insurance industry need to know to understand and arrange effective business insurance programs.

In simple terms, Mr Berwick explains risk management concepts, insurance of assets, liability cover placement, insurance classes, and industry regulation.

Information is easy to find, as each chapter is broken down to subsections that are clearly identified in the table of contents.

Mr Berwick makes good use of bullet points to highlight important concepts in each area.

Common policy wording pitfalls are outlined for each insurance class and case studies are provided to illustrate the need for care.

The book is a well-written, simple-to-use reference to guide executives and industry participants through the insurance process.

Mr Berwick is managing director of QR Consulting, which specialises in insurance industry consulting. He has more than 25 years' experience in the insurance industry in Australia and globally. He is a former board member of the National Insurance Brokers' Association and an ANZIIF fellow.
