The Executives Guide to Insurance and Risk Management

This book, now in its second edition, focuses squarely on the insurance side of risk transfer and aims to provide comprehensive coverage of insurance issues in the Asia-Pacific region. The original 2001 edition has been updated to reflect the myriad changes in the insurance market and has expanded considerably.

Author Graeme Berwick has put together a comprehensive guide covering almost every aspect of insurance from captive insurance companies to insurer and broker selection. The book also offers easy reference access through the well-organised chapters and sub headings.

Far from being just a review of the market, The Executive Guide offers a comprehensive analysis of all things insurance including insurance of assets, liability insurance, insurance of human resources, industry regulation as well as wording pitfalls to avoid and the coverage enhancements needed in today's environment.
